# Registration Information

**Admissions Requirements** – Individuals may take up to a total of 5 credit hours without applying to the college. After completing 5 hours, one must complete the full admission process to continue taking classes.

**Priority Registration** – Priority Registration is an opportunity for upper class students to have first preference in scheduling classes. Students are given access to MyCCU based on cumulative hours earned. Registration forms submitted in person will be processed as quickly as possible but are not guaranteed to be processed during the priority time for the student's class standing.

5 pm Tuesday March 29	Juniors (62-95 hours completed)
8 am Thursday March 31	Sophomores (30-61 hours completed)
8 am Friday April 1	Freshmen (0-29 hours completed)

**Registration Instructions** – To receive priority treatment, students are encouraged to register online at <http://my.ccuniversity.edu>. Students must have their school ID number and a PIN assigned by the IT Department to access their account. Students with outstanding balances or who are not in good academic standing cannot register via MyCCU.

**Schedule Changes** – Before classes begin and during the first week of the semester, changes in registration may be done via MyCCU. After the first week of the semester, changes in registration may be done by phone or in person. After the refund period, students must have the instructor's signature on an official "Change in Registration" form. This form must be presented in person to the Registrar's Office. Changes in registrations are not official until received in the Registrar's Office. All refunds are calculated from the official date the form is received in the Registrar's Office.

**Contact Information** – Students are encouraged to keep their contact information up to date by submitting changes through MyCCU. All students are given a CCU email address. It is especially important that students check this email account on a regular basis.

**Students should consult the catalog for specific details about academic policies and guidelines.**

While Cincinnati Christian University provides academic advising for degree-seeking students, **the final responsibility** for meeting all program/degree requirements and being informed of all academic regulations and procedures **rests with the student.**
