Those who complete the four courses will receive a certificate of participation. The 12 hours can also be taken for academic credit.

What is the purpose of the Russell School of Ministry?

It is way to honor the life and ministry of Bob and Judy Russell, and to provide classes that reflect the philosophy and principles that guide their ministry. It features a block of four classes, offered in the summer and winter sessions, that can be taken either for personal enrichment or academic credit. Bob Russell is scheduled to make an appearance in each class.

How will it be scheduled?

The school will hold its inaugural class on January 7-11, 2008. This class is entitled “Contemporary Preaching.” Dr. Barry McCarty, Senior Minister of Valley View Christian Church, will be the lead teacher. The summer class will be “Leading by Serving and Serving by Leading.” This class will be led by Dr. Gary Johnson, Senior Minister of Indian Creek Christian Church. Future topics include, “Creative Methods for Evangelism and Community Impact,” and “Blending Biblical Truth with Human Need.”

How will Bob Russell be involved?

Each class will feature a guest appearance by Bob.

How can I use this?

Those who complete the four courses will receive a certificate of participation. As mentioned above, the 12 hours can either be taken for academic credit or for personal enrichment.
